Study Questions

1. 1 Timothy 2:1-2,

- a. What are the forms of prayer that Paul lists and how are they different?
- b. Who does Paul encourage the church to pray for?
- c. Why do you think the church would have found it a challenge to pray for all these people in the past?

2. 1 Timothy 2:2b-4,

- a. What reasons does Paul give for praying for other people?
- b. How do our prayers link into God's mission of people being saved?
- c. How can prayers I make in Uganda impact people in a place far away that I might even never visit?

3. 1 Timothy 2:5-7,

- a. Why is it essential for Paul to remind Timothy and the church about the One God and One Mediator?
- b. In which ways is Jesus' role as the One Mediator important for all people?

4. 1 Timothy 2:7-8,

- a. What ungodly elements does Paul point out that should be far away from us in our approach to and in prayer?
- b. How do these affect or hinder our prayers?
- c. How can we keep our hands holy?

5. "Before you tell people about God, tell God about the people" – unknown

- a. How does this passage challenge us in regards to our scope of prayer i.e. who or what we should pray for?
- b. How can we be intentional about prioritizing prayer?
- c. How can we be intentional about praying for non-believers?
